SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

- Police apprehended a male adult that we approached for trespassing at a restaurant. The male adult took a swing at the ambassador and proceeded to swing at tourists along Virginia.
- Ambassadors were called to the Golden Flower where they encountered a male adult who was extremely intoxicated. The owners asked to have him removed because he fell in the entrance and couldn't get back up. Ambassador walked him to two different hotels that wouldn't accept him because of his condition. Due to his inability to care for himself, RPD was called and he was safely taken to the drunk tank for the night out of the cold.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Ambassadors developed a relationship with Health Plan of Nevada who provides wrap around services, including housing for those with that specific Medicaid.
- Created monthly meetings with code enforcement to have a consistent and up to date strategy for maintaining streets.
- Created partnership with RPD downtown bike team that will allow the DRP to share information on problem individuals.
- Met with Judge Riggs from Community Court about working with the ambassadors to help get individuals to necessary resources through her new program.
- Toured REMSA (ambulance) and their Dispatch Center.
- Met with Fire Chief Cochran and will present to the Captains next month.
