

NO LOITERING PROGRAM

The No Loitering Program in partnership with the Reno Police Department provides an avenue for businesses to establish a collaborative approach to address unlawful activity on private property, including, but not limited to, side shows, street racing, fights, narcotic sales, and other crimes. Through Reno Municipal Code titled "Offenses Against Property" Title 8, Chapter 8.10, businesses have the opportunity to sign up for this program, which authorizes the Reno Police Department to trespass individuals at participating locations without a property owner onsite.

HOW TO SIGN UP

Program details can be found on Loiter.RenoPD.com and include the following requirements:

- A program Letter of Authority on file with the Reno Police Department. These can be completed online or in person at the Public Safety Center.
- Purchase of a No Loitering sign from the Public Safety Center. Signs are \$40 each. Unofficial signs will not be permitted.

SIGNAGE BEST PRACTICES

Signs must be hung between 5-7 feet from the ground.

If the property does not contain any lineal dimension exceeding three hundred feet, by posting signs at each corner of the area and at intervals not exceeding 100 feet and, if such property has a definite entrance or entrances.

Signs shall not be a visibility hazard to traffic on adjacent streets or parking areas.

Signs shall not reduce parking availability as required by Reno Municipal Code Title 18.

Signs shall not interfere with on-site vehicular circulation.

Signs shall not be posted on windows.

A sign permit is not required for this program.

If property has lineal dimensions exceeding 300 feet, by posting signs at each corner of the area and at intervals not exceeding 200 feet and, if such property has a definite entrance or entrances.
